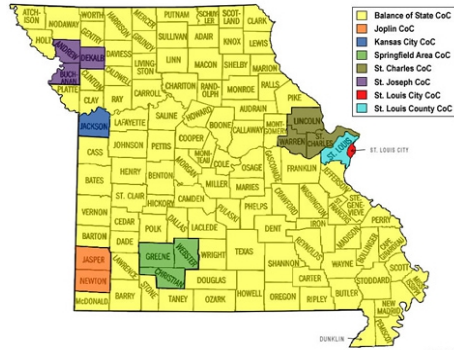
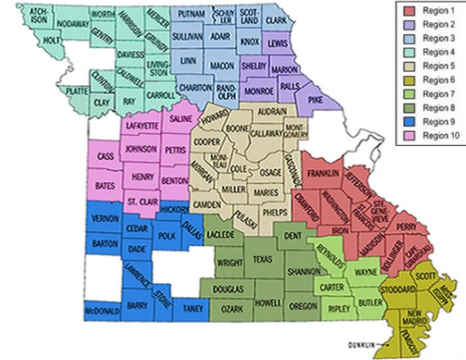


Missouri Continuums of Care
